The course provides a critical understanding of the tools and techniques to implement complex developmental projects. The modules for the course include:

1. Land acquisition, resettlement and rehabilitation laws and policies
2. Consultations and communications with stakeholders
3. Social Impact Assessment (SIA) & Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA)
4. Building & implementing a Resettlement Action Plan (RAP)
5. Rehabilitation & livelihood restoration of affected people
6. Data management and management information systems for resettlement programs
7. Monitoring and evaluation of resettlement action plan
